FORUM: Special Political and Decolonization Committee

QUESTION OF: The elimination of sexual exploitation in peacekeeping operations

SUBMITTER: Syrian Arab Republic

THE FOURTH COMMITTEE,

- (01) *Emphasizing* that sexual exploitation and abuse by members of peacekeeping
(02) operations is unacceptable and utterly immoral,
- (03) *Noting with regret* crimes such as rape, prostitution and pedophilia which
(04) where committed in Haiti, Liberia, the Democratic Republic of Congo,
(05) Cambodia, Ivory Coast and many other countries over the past years,
- (06) *Aware of the fact* that the mission of peacekeeping operations is to bring
(07) security and food without return service,
- (08) *Reminding* that the UN has a policy of zero tolerance towards sexual abuse
(09) especially of children,
- (10) *Supposing* that there are more examples of sex offenders which are not
(11) republished,
- (12) 1. **Urges** the UN to increase the punishment in case of a criminal act,
(13) which means an immediate reshipment to the country of origin,
(14) exclusion of further UN missions and prosecution;
- (15) 2. **Calls upon** all member states to impose an adequate penalty on the
(16) criminal offender;
- (17) 3. **Recommends** all troops of peacekeeping operations to discipline all
(18) troops in ethics and morale to prevent such cases;
- (19) 4. **Suggests** to found an organisation which has the task to
(20) a) receive complains and analyse them
(21) b) present the results as statistical chart to this committee by
(22) i) keeping the victims anonymous
(23) ii) categorize the cases
(24) c) try to find solutions for each case.
